

Public hearing on rural power set

The Alaska Public Utilities Commission has scheduled a public hearing and a teleconference to consider the adoption of regulations governing the interconnection, purchases, and sales of electric power between cogenerators and small power producers and the economically re-

gulated electric utilities in Alaska.

The public hearing will begin at 9 a.m. on July 28 at the APUC's offices in Anchorage. The teleconference will be held on the Alaska Legislative Tele-
