

# Womens' conference set

A women's regional mid-conference will be held from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. July 31 to discuss alcoholism as it effects the family, safety of women and children, how to be heard, employment and education, culture and heritage and the Alaska Native Women's Statewide Organization.

The conference is sponsored by the Women in Crisis Counseling and Assistance, the Alaska Native Women's Statewide Organization-Doyon Region, and in cooperation with the Family Services of Tanana Chiefs Con-

ference. Some funding is being provided by the Alaska Commission on the Status of Women.

Other discussions will be held to generate further topics for a regional conference with an expanded forum to be held in the fall.

The conference is being held during the World Eskimo-Indian Olympics but a location for the mini-conference will be announced later.
