PUBLIC NOTICE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS

According to AS 08.18.141, any person acting as a construction contractor sho is not licensed as a construction contractor according to AS 08.18.011 is guilty of a Class B misdemeanor. A contractor who employs an unregistered contractor is also guilty of a Class B misdemeanor. A person who violates any other provision of AS 08.18 will be considered guilty of a violation punishable under AS 12.

The Department of Commerce and Economic Developm or the Department of Commerce and Economic Development or the Department of Labor may issue a citation when there is probable cause to believe a person has violated any of the provisions of AS 08.18. Each day a person's unlawful conduct continues, after a citation has been issued, will be considered a seperate violation. The recipient of a citation is required to appear in court at the time and place specified on the citation; failure to appear as required is a Class B misdemeans.


