An Act Relating to the Relocation of the Capital of Alaska

Section 1, Purpose

It is the purpose of this act to insure that the people of Alaska will have the opportunity to make an intelligent and objective decision on relocating the capital with all pertinent data available to them concerning the costs to the State, including the social, economic and environmental costs involved; and, further to insure the costs of relocating the capital will not be incurred by the State without the approval of the electorate.

Section 2, Capital Relocation Expenditures

State money may be expended to relocate physically the present functions of the State government, including but not limited to the legislature the governor's office and all offices of the heads of the principal departments from their present location only after a majority of those voting in a statewide election have approved a bond issue which includes all bondable costs of the relocation to the State through the year 1992, as determined by a commission created by the legislature to plan the relocation. In determining the bondable costs to the State the commission shall also determine the total costs to the State. Those costs shall include, but not be limited to, the costs of moving personnel and offices to the relocation site; the social, economic and environmental costs to the present and relocation sites; and, the cost to the State of planning, building, furnishing, using and financing a new capital city having facilities equal to those provided by the present capital city and those required by the 1974 Capital Move Initiative.
