The mobile art van program was created by the Bureau of Indian Affairs in response to criticism from some Indian parents that cultural aspects of the American Indian heritage are often neglected in the cult are often neglected in the cur-

The program is being financed under provisions of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (Title I) which provide for special aid to schools serving low income families.

Public schools with sizeable Indian student enrollments are also eligible for visitations from the BIA's mobile art studios, which will leave behind supplies of art supplies at each school.

Students will also be taught to create art forms from indigenous materials-pigments ground from stone, water colors blended from berries and other traditional materials


