Harriet Wulf was elected village council president in December. Harriet, 19 years old, completed high school in June of 1972 at Anchorage West High School.

Harriet is the first woman

from Shageluk to hold the position and may be the youngest person, male or female, ever to be elected president of a village council.

Another woman, Agnes Ivanoff Baptiste, has been chosen village council president of Unalakleet and is the first woman in that village ever to be chosen for the position.
