Foledo, a native of Gallup, N.M., failed to report for induction in 1969 as a conscientious objector. During his trial in Newark, N.J., Toledo told the court his great-grandfather was killed in a battle with U.S. cavality troopers and that this had affected his attitudes toward the U.S., military.

A court ruling last summer in a related case stated that ribbal religions must be treated on a par with the Christian denominational religious as a basis for conscientious objection to inflats service.
