MANAGEMENT PERMIT. (a) No operate a solid waste disposal facility without a permit, except the following:

(1) a residence on which solid waste is generated and disposed of, (2) a farm on which solid waste generated from the operation of that farm is disposed:

(b) An application for a permit shall contain two sets of the following, submitted to the department for approval:

(1) a completed permit application form:

(3) evidence of compliance with local zoning requirements;

(4) a report detailing the proposed method of operation, population and area to be served, the characteristics, quantity and source of material to be processed, the use and distribution of processed the use and distribution of processed method of operations and amount of equipment to be provided.
