LINCOLN, NEB. — Parents who have experienced a miscarriage are urged to contact the University of Nebraska Miscarriage Project to participate in a research survey.

"Miscarriage is an invisible crisis, but that does not make it any less a crisis in the lives of hundreds of thousands of mothers and fathers each year in our country," said Dr. John DeFram, director of the project. "The more we know about what is happening in these families, the more we can be of help by building a caring, supportive community."
