

Nominations due by Dec. 1

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Take Pride in America, the national campaign started through the Interior Department to encourage wiser use of the nation's natural and cultural resources, has set Dec. 1 as the deadline for nominations in its 1987 awards program.

Awards are given in 12 categories this year, including the "federal government" category for the BIA and the "local government" category for Indian tribes.

The program recognizes outstanding efforts to preserve, improve and educate citizens about America's natural and cultural resources. Indian tribes that would like to nominate a project should contact their respective state offices. The nomination consists of a three-page application and a two-page summary statement.
