

# KALTAG SCHOOLS FOR SURE

Kaltag villagers will for certain see their youngsters back in school this fall, after fire swept through and destroyed the two-room BIA school there July 7.

BIA officials in Fairbanks yesterday confirmed that temporary school buildings—enough for three classrooms and two sets of teacher's living quarters—will be set up in the lower Yukon village in time for school.

Wallace Craig, Bureau Area Director in Fairbanks, said that "every effort" would be made to meet a September 1 deadline in putting up the prefabricated buildings.

Flames swept through the old school late July 7. No cause for the fire has yet been found, Craig said, although it is known to have started somewhere around the building's heating unit.
