Guide pleads to violation, sentenced

A State Fish and Wildlife Protection undercover operation conducted in the fall of 1981 resulted in an Aug. 16 no contest plea from Registered Guide Larry R. Bryant, of Iliamna.

Bryant, 35, pleaded no contest to four counts of game and guiding violations which stemmed from October 1981 brown bear and caribou hunts near Iliamna.

Bryant aided non-resident hunter Jeff Sager from Pennsylvania to take bown bear and caribou same day airborne. Bryant then transported the trophies in his Super Cub aircraft back to Iliamna.

Under terms of the plea, Bryant will lose his registered guide license for 10 years effective January 1, 1983, and be sentenced to 18 months jail time and a \$4000 fine.

All jail time and fine are suspended on the condition he have no Fish and Wildlife violations for five years.

Bryant's Super Cub aircraft was forfeited to the State of Alaska.
