
EARLIER THIS YEAR THE NEW CAPITAL SITE PLANNING COMMISSION SET AN INFLATION RATE FOR COSTS IN THE NEW WILLOW SITE AT 11% PER YEAR COMPOUNDED FOR THE NEXT 12 YEARS. HOW DID THEY COME UP WITH THIS FIGURE?

According to a report in the Anchorage Times dated Dec. 22, 1981, for the period of November 1980 thru November 1981, the inflation rate in Anchorage (and Willow) was 7.1% for this yearly period. In fact, national inflation was only 3% for February, 1982.

Their reason? They have a majority of "anti-move" members on the Committee, and this helps them to drive up the costs in Willow - and reduce the future costs of leaving the capital in Juneau.
