signs contract

Last month the Cook Inlet Housing Authority held a historical contract signing ceremony in Cook Inlet Native Association's conference room at 1057 West Fireweed Lane in Anchorage. The contracts which were signed were for subdivision development and construction of 27 houses at Tyonek.

complete and 27 families moved in by next August.

In addition to the twenty-seven (27) homes in Tyonek, the Housing Authority anticipates signing contracts this winter for seven homes in Eklutna and 18 units of elderly housing at Sel-dovia.

Attending the signing ceremony were Max Dolchok, Chairman of the Housing Authority Board; Agnes Brown, President of Tyonek Native Corporation; Roy Huhndorf, President of Cook Inlet Region, Inc.; Robert Rude, President of Cook Inlet Native Association; Ned Locke, Deputy Director of the Housing Authority. Bonnie McCord, President of the Native village of Tyonek and Frank Standifer, Housing Authority representative from Tyonek, were unable to attend due to bad weather.

Also attending were Chili Belarde, President of Comanche Corporation and Stanley Miller, General Manager of Atco Structures. Comanche Corporation is beginning to work immediately on road construction and the water system construction within the new Tyonek subdivision. Atco Structures will be building the homes in their modular factory in Anchorage. The modules will be barged to Tyonek next spring.
