ALAKANUK & ENMONAK) WERE ORDERED TO PAY OVER
\$22,350.00 FOR THE \$2,000 WORTH OF FISH THEY
CAUGHT.

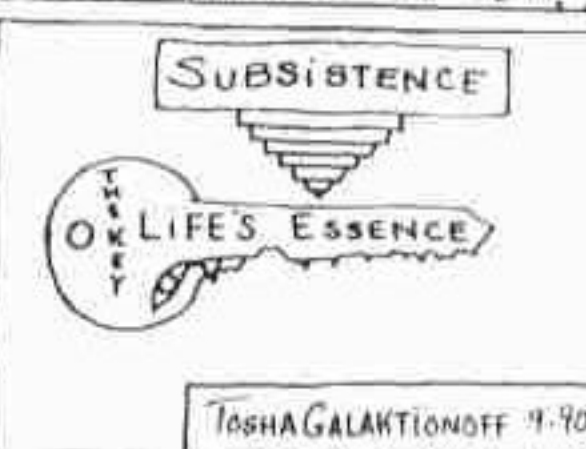
