

Aleut League Honors Times Editor for Work on Aleut Behalf

The editor of Tundra Times, Howard Rock, was elected as an honorary member of the Aleut League, an Aleut organization organized last month in Anchorage.

The League's President, Flore Lekanof in his notification of the honor wrote:

"Last month during the first meeting of the Aleut League, you were elected as an honorary member of the League. It is with great pleasure for me to inform you of this honor."

"This honor was bestowed upon you for the great services you have rendered on behalf of the Aleut people. Congratulations!"

In its constitution, the League defined the status of the honorary members:

"Honorary members are persons on whom the Board

of Directors specifically confers the status of an honorary member. Honorary membership shall be based upon outstanding service or performance to the League or its objectives. Honorary members have all privileges of membership other than voting or holding office."
