INVITATION FOR BIDS

SEALED BIDS will be received
in the office of the Commissioner
of Public Works, Juneau, Alaska,
until 2:00 p.m. PST, May 16, 1968,
for furnishing all labor, equipment,
material and performing all work for
the construction of an Airport at
Grayling, Alaska.

Plans and specifications may be
reviewed at the Department of
Public Works, Juneau; the Division
of Aviation, Anchorage; the Construction
Plan Bureau, Fairbanks; and the AGC
offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks and
Seattle. Plans and specifications may
be obtained from the Director, Division
of Aviation, 4510 International Airport
Road, Anchorage, Alaska 99502.

Construction items include approximately:
35.8 acres of clearing; 9.1 acres of
clearing and grubbing; 14,000 cubic
yards of stripping; 12,800 cubic yards
of Class I embankment; 5,200 cubic
yards of surface course material; 48
linear feet of culverts; and one wind
cone and segmented circle.

The work shall be completed on
or before November 1, 1968.
