

Communities get grants from FAA

Three Alaska communities have received grants from the Federal Aviation Administration's Department of Transportation to purchase land for improvements to the airports serving the communities, according to Congressman Don Young.

Palmer has received a grant of \$775,590 to acquire land for approaches to the municipal airport.

Golovin has been awarded \$346,759 to purchase land for airport approaches and additional development.

Ambler has received an increase of \$312,412 to purchase additional land to extend the runway and safety apron and for runway lighting at the airport. Ambler received an earlier grant of about \$1.4 million for the project.
