The Arctic District Office of the Bureau of Land Management will hold a public meeting in Anaktuvuk Pass. The meeting will provide a public forum to discuss and take formal comments on the Utility Corridor Draft Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement. One part of the meeting will be a general discussion of BLM's proposed recommendations for managing natural resources throughout the planning area. Another part of the meeting will be a formal public hearing on the subsistence uses and needs within this same area. The public is encouraged to attend the meeting in order to formally and informally express their views on BLM's management recommendations in this draft management plan.

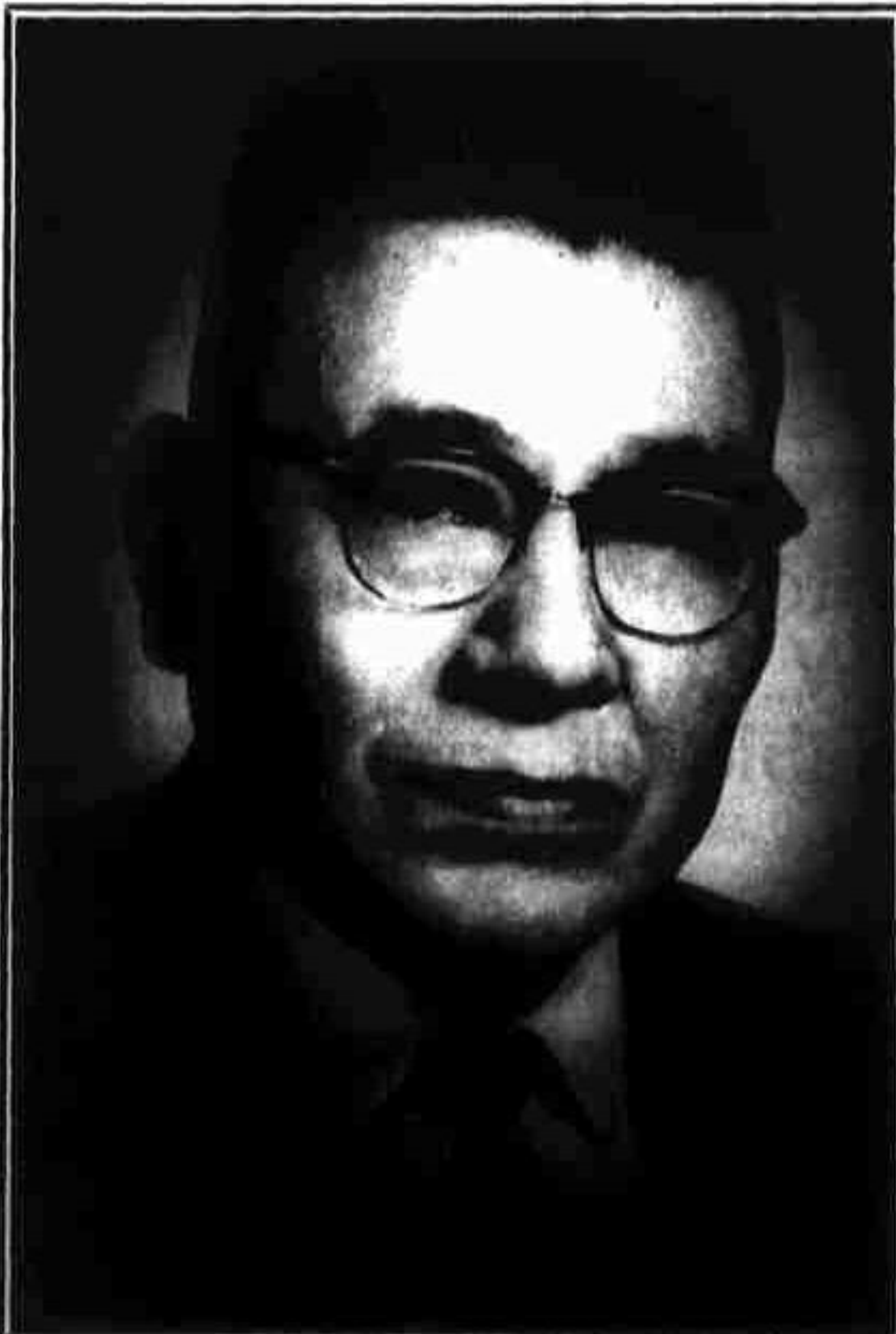
Anaktuvuk Pass
