The Arctic District Office of the Bureau of Land Management will hold public meetings in Bettles/Evensville and Stevens Village. These meetings will provide a public forum to discuss and take formal comments on the Utility Corridor Draft Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement. One part of these meetings will be a general discussion of BLM's proposed recommendations for managing natural resources throughout the planning area. Another part of these meetings will be a formal public hearing on the subsistence uses and needs within this same area. The public is encouraged to attend these meetings in order to formally and informally express their views on BLM's management recommendations in this draft management plan.

A general public meeting will be held in Stevens Village at the Community Center at 12 noon on October 15, 1987. A formal hearing on the issue of subsistence needs and uses will immediately follow this general meeting.
