Appearing with Larry will be Miss Alaska, Cindy Suryan of Kodiak. Cindy will be working with the show all summer prior to her appearance in Atlantic City in September in the Miss American Pageant.

As Alaska's Ambassador of Good Will, Larry has performed in most of the "Lower 48" both on television and in over 2000 live performances.

"We try to present some of the Robert Service Favorites," states Beck, "but we also present some of his lesser known poems along with my own poems of Alaska."
