Errors in Fishing Regulations

JUNEAU—Anglers should take note of two errors in the 1975 sport fishing regulation booket, the Department of Fish and Game announced recently.

The new anti-snagging regulation summarized on page 11 of the booklet applies only to fresh water.

Under the new regulation, it is unlawful to intentionally snag or attempt to snag any fish while sport fishing in fresh water. Fish unintentionally hooked elsewhere than in the mouth

while sport fishing in fresh water must be released immediately. This regulation is in force statewide.

In' regulatory area 5-Cook Inlet and Lower Susitna River drainages-Rabbit Creek (Potter Marsh) is closed to all fishing.
