

Special Notice To Mariners

JUNEAU — The Coast Guard in Alaska has produced a special notice to mariners for the 1975 boating season. The 52-page booklet contains information that will be helpful to all mariners, be they novices or masters.

Included in the annual publication is information about Coast Guard safety broadcasts; proper use of marine radio communication systems; distress procedures; helicopter evacuation procedures; and, how to operate Coast Guard droppable pumps.

Also, the booklet tells about current boating regulations; personal flotation devices; float plans; oil pollution and refuse regulations; and, the meaning of aids to navigation.
