BIA's Stancampiano gets promotion

Michael J. Stancampiano has been named superintendent of the Fairbanks Agency of the Bureau of Indian Affairs by Area Director Jake Lestenkof.

Stancampiano, 40, has been serving as acting superintendent of the Pair-banks Agency since February 1986, replacing Perry Baker who moved to another bureau agency in Utah.

As superintendent, Stancampiano is responsible for the agency's \$7 million annual budget and for administering all programs and contracts for social services, employment assistance,

education, housing, tribal operations and land management for the 47 villages in Alaska's Interior region.

Stancampiano previously worked as tribal operations officer and Native services officer for the Fairbanks Agency.

He was originally employed by the bureau in 1981 as a land law examiner in the Juneau Area Office and was promoted to assistant tribal operations officer in 1983. He joined the Fairbanks agency in 1985.
