

# Social Security Agent To Be Here

Jim Mara, social security representative, will be visiting Fairbanks on Tuesday—July 6 thru July 9—Friday. He will hold business hours during 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. in Room One of the Post Office Building.

Jim would like to talk with all people within three months of their 62nd birthday, who have not yet filed claims for retirement benefits. Monthly benefits may be lost if timely claims are not filed. Many seasonal workers who still earn well over \$1200 a year may still be entitled to some benefits checks.

Those who wish to file retirement claims should come prepared with their birth certificate, their social security card, their W-2 form for 1964, or if self-employed, their federal tax returns for 1964 and evidence of tax payment.

Jim strongly suggests that all people within three months of their 65th birthday file applications now—even though they are still working. This would establish their potential entitlement to retirement benefits and also ensure them of receiving their hospital benefit card should the current medicare bill be enacted next month.
