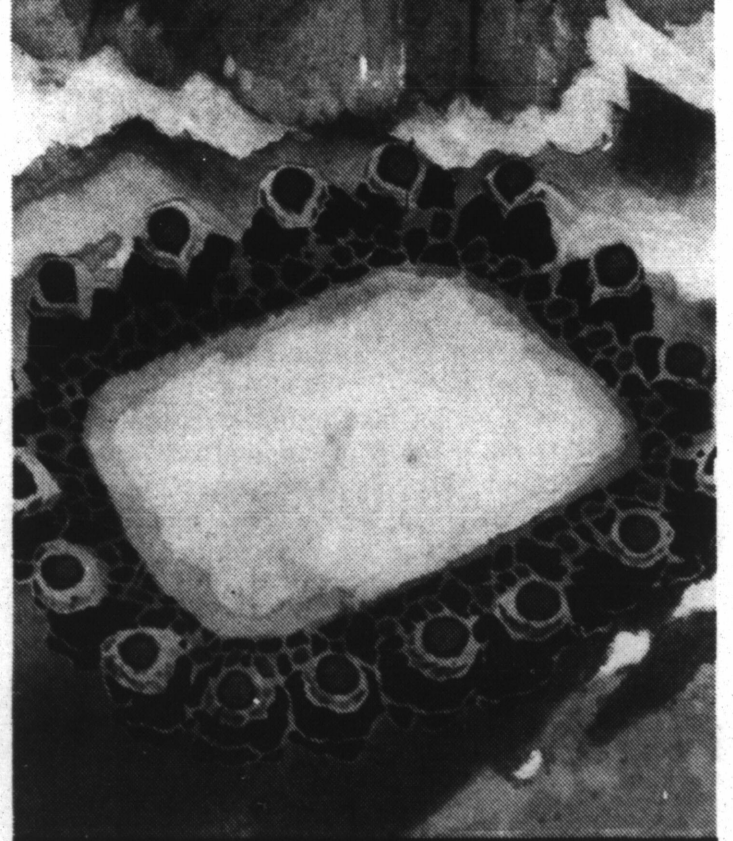

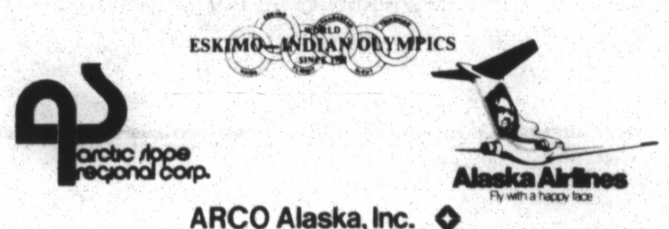
TERMS: All items must be paid for at the close of sale activities on the above date. Non personalized checks (counter checks) are not acceptable as payment.
