

Kodiak Rotary Club starts educational fund for victims

A permanent trust fund has been established by the Kodiak Rotary Club to provide support for the educational needs of the 11 surviving children of the six crew members who perished in the crash of a U.S. Coast Guard helicopter Nov. 2 off Kodiak Island.

In addition to the surviving children, the trust will benefit surviving children of similar disasters involving Coast Guard or civilian personnel assigned to or working from the Kodiak Coast Guard Station who perish in the performance of their duty.

The goal of the Kodiak Rotary Club is to raise \$100,000 so that the trust will be able to provide continuing educational benefits for the 11 children, who range in age from 4

months to 21 years, as well as for additional surviving children of similar disasters.
