The North Slope Higher Education Center (NSHEC) is a recently created institution, with its administrative offices in Barrow, Alaska. The NSHEC will provide post-high school academic education, and will develop a range of university accredited in-service, certificate and degree programs that will help meet the educational needs of the North Slope residents.

It is called the North Slope Higher Education Center, because, at present, it does not have independent status as an accredited institution of higher education. However, for academic pur-

poses, it has its status as an affiliate of the University of Alaska-Fairbanks (UAF). All academic credits, certificates, programs and degrees would come through the UAF. The NSHEC would have the accreditation of the UAF and therefore, must satisfy the academic standards of the UAF. As a goal, the NSHEC will maintain such a satellite accreditation relationship until some point in the future, when it will seek its own independent accreditation. The NSHEC is an autonomous management unit of the North Slope Borough under the control of the North Slope Higher Education Board.

The North Slope Borough, with its 86,000 square miles of territory and approximately 9,000 people, occupies most of the Alaskan Arctic. It is the largest regional municipality in the United States and encompasses eight Inupiat villages, as well as the Prudhoe Bay/Kuparuk petroleum complexes.

The NSHEC is seeking applications for an Academic Coordinator. The coordinator will live in Barrow, but frequent travel to the other villages will be required. The coordinator should have multiple interests and expertise, a commitment to the development of a locally controlled higher education institution, strong scholarly promise, a sense of the importance of community-oriented applied research, and cross-cultural experience.

Qualifications

—Earned doctorate or ABD with significant experience in developing institutions, cross-cultural situations, and academic administrative experience.

—Interdisciplinary background in preferably more than one of the following areas: social science, international development and education, education or an area of humanities, and management.

—Ability to meet the University of Alaska-Fairbanks requirements for a faculty appointment.

—Demonstrated ability to work in cross-cultural situations, particularly with Native American groups.

—Experience with Alaska Native People or other Americans.

—Ability to teach a wide spectrum of courses within areas of expertise.

—Demonstrated interest and ability in community-oriented applied research.

—Classroom teaching experience.

Preferred Qualities

—Prior experience with field based or distance delivered programs in rural cross-cultural settings.

—Interest in learning the Inupiat language and actively participating in the sociocultural activities of the Inupiat communities.

—Experience in counseling students.

The North Slope Higher Education Center (NSHEC) invites nominations and applications for the position of Director. The NSHEC is a newly established locally controlled and funded public postsecondary institution serving the educational and professional needs of Alaska's North Slope Borough. It is currently in its first semester of operation. The Center provides a wide range of in-service, certificate, and baccalaureate programs and degrees.

The center offers academic credit and related degrees through the University of Alaska Fairbanks (UAF). NSHEC faculty receive affiliate UAF faculty appointments and all courses meet at least minimum UAF standards. It is called the North Slope Higher Education Center, because, at present, it does not have independent status as an accredited institution of higher education. As a goal, the NSHEC will maintain such an affiliate accreditation relationship until some point in the future, when it will seek its own independent accreditation.

The Director reports to a Board of Directors, comprised of seven members, who are nominated by the communities located within the Borough's 86,000 square mile jurisdiction and confirmed by the Borough Assembly.

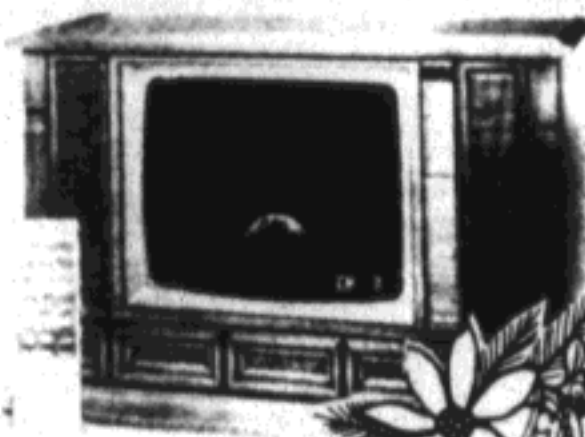
