Is your community involved in a special art project? The Alaska State Council on the Arts may be able to assist you through its Community Arts Development Grant program.

Community Arts Development Grants are designed to assist small nonprofit Alaskan organizations develop art programs in underserved areas of the state and/ or underserved disciplines. Exhib-

its, concerts, dance performances and festivals, workshops, readings, theater productions are examples of the kinds of arts projects funded through this grant category. Grants will also be given to assist developing organizations in the area of arts administration such as board development, accounting systems and budget development.

There are four application

deadlines: October 1, January 1, April 1, and July 1.
