As Episcopal Bishop of the Yukon, Bishop Marsh's district covers the entire area between Old Crow and the border of British Columbia. The Yukon has a population of 16,000.

While in Alaska the Marsh's were the guests of Bishop Gordon of Fairbanks. They made trips to Point Hope, Eagle, Tanacross, Valdez and Mt. McKinley Park.

Calvin Oktolik was their host at Point Hope and guided them on a trip looking for wildlife. The Marsh's saw seals, murre, eiders and, surprisingly, three moose, a rarity in those parts.
