

# Cohen named to ADF&G post

Norman Cohen has been appointed deputy commissioner of the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, according to Commissioner Don W. Collinsworth.

Cohen is a member of the Alaska and Connecticut Bars, having graduated from Dartmouth College in 1972 and the University of Connecticut School of Law in 1975. He came to Alaska in 1975 where he worked

as an attorney for the Alaska Legal Services Corp. in Bethel, as well as holding a number of other positions.

From 1981 until 1983, Cohen worked on resource issues for Nunam Kitlutsisti, a nonprofit corporation which represents the interests of Southwest Alaska village residents on environmental issues. He served as director of the corporation in 1982.
