

Roederer reappointed to Arctic panel

WASHINGTON, D.C. — The Alaska Congressional Delegation announced recently that, acting on their recommendation, President Reagan has reappointed Dr. Juan Roederer of Fairbanks to the Arctic Research Commission.

Roederer, professor of physics at the Geophysical Institute of the University of Alaska, has been a member of the commission since its inception in 1985. His new four-year term expires in February 1991.
