

Improvements

If you need more money to make a lot of energy-saving improvements to your home, you might be able to get a state loan of up to \$5,000 at five percent interest for 10 years.

To get the loan you need two things:

1—An Energy Audit. The loan may only be used for things recommended in the audit. If you have problems in getting a regular energy audit, call the Division of Business Loans at the number below. They can arrange an informal audit, over the telephone if necessary.

2—Collateral for the loan. Collateral is something like a boat or other valuable possession which you agree to let the lender have if you don't pay back the loan.
