## Soll will replace Hickey as Chief of Criminal Division

On March 10, former Alaska Public Defender Herbert Soll will assume the post of Chief of the Criminal Division, replacing Chief Prosecutor Dan Hickey, who resigned last year.

Soll, 49, is presently a judge on the High Court of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, a position he has held since September of last year. Prior to that, he was a judge for the Northern Marianas Islands.

In 1959, Soll came to Alaska, where he served for several years as a Fairbanks district attorney before joining the Peace Corps. Soll spent several years in Brazil, then returned to Alaska in 1970 to join the Alaska Public Defender Agency, where he remained until 1975.
