-STAFF TRAINING-

The Department of Community and Regional Affairs, Division of Community Employment and Training Assistance, and the Municipality of Anchorage CETA Program, in conjunction with the Private Industry Council, is requesting proposals to provide training to field staff on the delivery of CETA Programs in the private sector.

Training should occur in a workshop setting and be designed for 20-30 participants. At the completion of training, staff should have a working knowledge of the program philosophy and regulatory requirements; should be equipped with the basic skills necessary to develop private sector agreements; should have sufficient information on the private sector environment to market government funds for vocational training.

A manual for in-house training of future staff is an additional requirement.

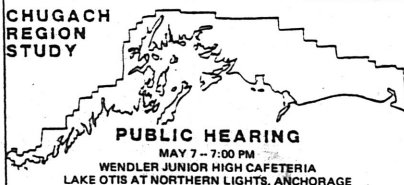

- Why areas should or should not be conveyed to Chugach Natives, Inc.
- Coastal accessibility, economic viability, or traditional use by Natives of lands within the Chugach Region.
- What combinations of land and/or cash settlements you would prefer to meet provisions of the Alaska Lands Act for Chugach Natives, Inc.
- What areas outside the Chugach Region might be considered for conveyance to Chugach Natives, Inc.
- Where National Forest, Park or Wildlife Refuge boundaries in the Chugach Region could be adjusted to improve public land management.
- What additions to conservation system units you would like to see.
