Newspapers Donated to Alaska Library

A valuable file of the Juneau newspaper ALASKA NEWS, 1893-1897, was donated to the Alaska Historical Library by Fe-

lix Gordon Grey.

The ALASKA NEWS, a weekly newspaper, took over the printing press of the ALASKA MINER, according to Phyllis Nottingham, librarian for the Alaska Historical Library.

Among the material donated is an album of Nome photographs taken by Dobbs in early 1900. A ledger from the Levy and Cohen store at Dyea, 1881 - 1901, was also placed in the archives.

Such donations are most welcome and greatly assist those researching Alaska history.
