

Newspapers Donated to Alaska Library

A valuable file of the Juneau newspaper **ALASKA NEWS**, 1893-1897, was donated to the Alaska Historical Library by Felix Gordon Grey.

The **ALASKA NEWS**, a weekly newspaper, took over the printing press of the **ALASKA MINER**, according to Phyllis Nottingham, librarian for the Alaska Historical Library.

Among the material donated is an album of Nome photographs taken by Dobbs in early 1900. A ledger from the Levy and Cohen store at Dyva, 1881-1901, was also placed in the archives.

Such donations are most welcome and greatly assist those researching Alaska history.
