

UA Heads Asked Funds for OTZ Community College Prog.

KOTZEBUE — University of Alaska officials are being asked to include sufficient funds in the university's fiscal 1975 budget request for a regional community college program at Kotzebue.

The Kotzebue Area Health

Corp. passed a resolution to that effect Oct. 3, citing a special need for training in health, education, social services, community planning, land management and all aspects of business.

A copy of that resolution

went to Dr. Robert Hiatt, university president, with a letter from the urgency of the matter from Robert Schaeffer, executive director of Mauneluk Association Inc.

The health corporation is a

subsidiary of Mauneluk, the non-profit arm of NANA Regional Corporation Inc.

"The social problems and paraprofessional development needs that led the state legislature to appropriate funds for

the Kuskokwim Community College exist also in our region, although our region is not quite so populous and large as that of the Calista Corp.," Schaeffer said.

"We do not want an extension center, but rather want a community-controlled college," he added.
