NOTICE OF UTILITY CONTRACT FILING

The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION gives notice that ALASCOM, INC. (Alascom), a long lines telecommunications utility, has filed a special contract (TA349-98) between Alascom and the State of Alaska (State).

Under the contract Alascom uniquely classifies the State's intrastate toll as a new service: ON NET to OFF NET traffic. ON NET to OFF NET is defined as

All calls that originate from a State owned and maintained Switch, and terminate on a State owned Switch or terminate in any other location in Alaska not part of the State network.

The intrastate toll cost for ON NET to OFF NET is \$.2457/minute applicable to all intrastate calls regardless of time of day, day of week or rate band.

The contract also provides that

In return for the pricing schedule and services the State of Alaska will route twenty percent (20%) of all interstate and intrastate long distance telephone calls generated by its Anchorage, Juneau and Fairbanks nodal switching facilities through Alascom, Inc.

The contract also contains provisions addressing the following subjects:

If the Commission finds that the proposal by Alascom is not just and reasonable, the Commission may approve a rate or classification which varies from that proposed.
