

Native Mother/Daughter to begin recruitment

The Native Mother/Daughter Program of the YWCA will begin its recruitment January 22, 1995. The program is offered to sixth-grade girls and their mothers, and consists of a series of Saturday workshops with topics such as study skills, communication skills, refusal skills, grooming, Native heritage, and crafts. The program is made possible through a grant to the YWCA from the Governor's Substance Abuse Pre-

vention Grant., Cook Inlet Region, Inc., and Doyon, Limited.

Through the cooperation of the Native Student Services Center at the University of Alaska Anchorage, Big Sisters are recruited to work with the girls.
