

National Congress to convene in Albuquerque in October

The 36th annual convention of the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) has been called for October 1 through October 5, according to an announcement by NCAI president Veronica L. Murdock.

The convention will be held at the Albuquerque Inn at the Convention Center, Albuquerque, New Mexico, according to the announcement.

Ms. Murdock has also announced that NCAI is seeking applications for the position of executive director of the national Indian organization. The position will be advertised through August 22, 1979, with mailed applications on Federal form 171 to be postmarked not later than August 17, 1979.

In calling the convention, Ms. Murdock stated, "All member tribes, individual Indian members, and Associate members who have paid their dues and are in good standing are urged to attend the 36th annual convention. Individuals and tribes who are not presently members, we welcome you to join the organization and attend this most important convention."
