

Gulkana gets land

The Village of Gulkana received conveyance to 79,183 acres of land June 29. The land was transferred to the Sta-Keh Corp. from the Bureau of Land Management under provisions of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act.

Robert Arnold, assistant to the BLM state director for ANCSA, said the conveyance includes land on both sides of the Richardson Highway from mile 120, just north of the Gulkana Airport to mile 146, just south of Sourdough. It also includes land around Middle and Ewan lakes.
