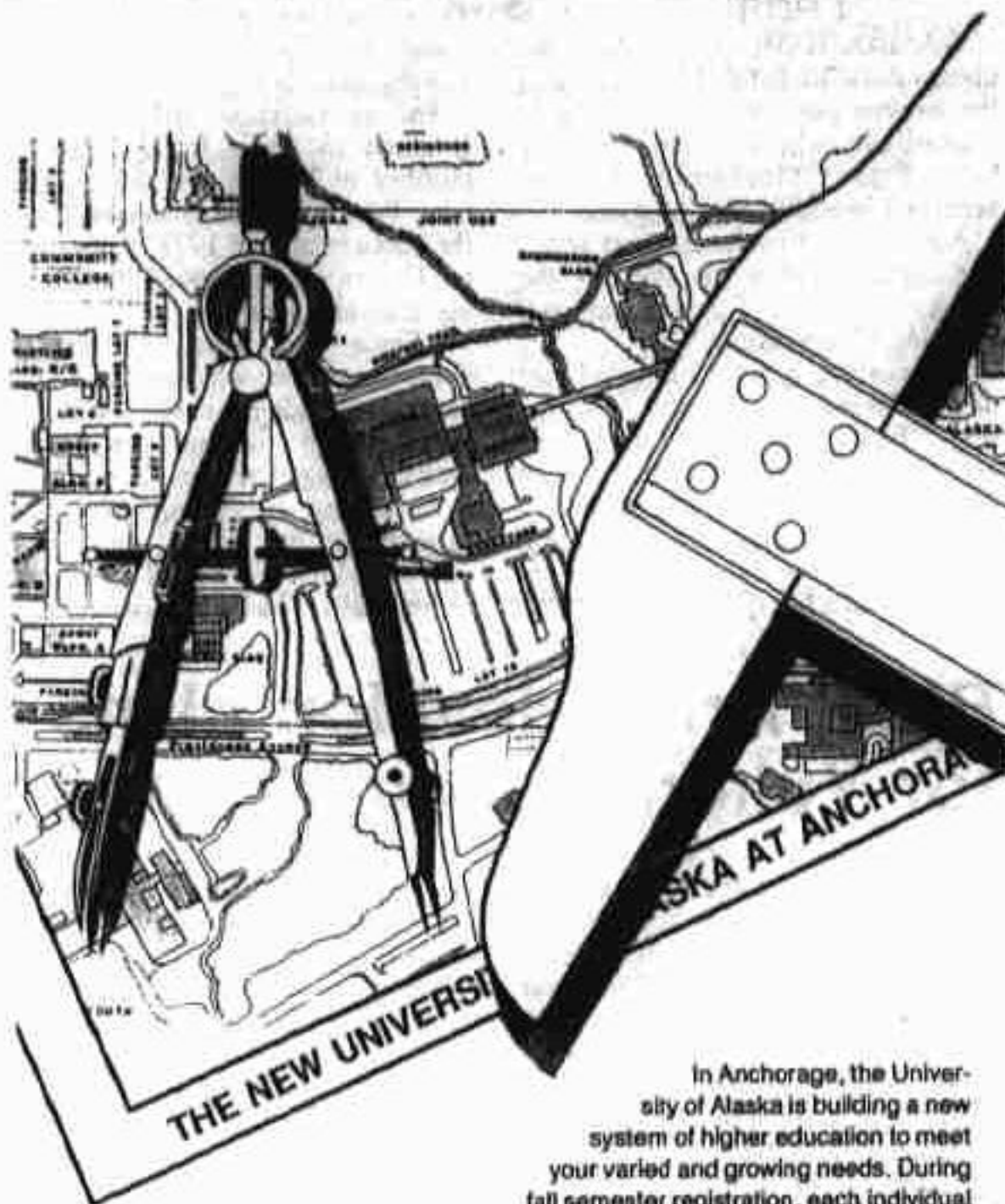


Building For The Future
