

## CLEAN STREAMS PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM



The Clean Streams Partnership Program is a municipal bond funded water quality improvement program. The Clean Streams Partnership Program offers a way for private citizens, community groups, and industry to assist with the rehabilitation and maintenence of degraded or threatened lakes, creeks and streams within the Municipality of Anchorage.

## Two types of partnerships are available:

- 1. A 3:1 dollar match: The municipality reimburses the applicant for 75% of approved project costs.
- 2. Materials for effort: The municipality provides approved vegetation for bank erosion prevention planting or reimbursal for other materials. The applicant does the work.

Possible projects include streambank revegetation or other bank stabilization strategies and drainage improvements. For participation in the Clean Streams Partnership Programs, projects must be approved prior to implementation.
