

Members sought for BLM council

The Bureau of Land Management is seeking to fill three positions on its Southern Alaska Advisory Council.

The categories include recreation, transportation/rights-of-way and renewable resources. Council members advise the BLM Anchorage and Glennallen district managers on issues related to public land and resources use occurring on BLM managed lands within the southern half of the state.

Terms are for three years, beginning Jan. 1, 1988. Current council members may be nominated for reappointment to additional terms.
