

lacking quorum —

Bering Straits meeting rescheduled for October 7

The Bering Straits Native Corporation annual meeting originally scheduled for June 10 was postponed for lack of a quorum. Those attending in person or by proxy voted to

reschedule the meeting to October 7, 1978, with a proxy deadline of October 1, 1978.

A factor in not obtaining a quorum was the time of year. Many shareholders are preparing for fishing season and other seasonal food-gathering activities. Proxies turned in are valid for 11 months. Additional solicitation will be made by the Regional Corporation to those stockholders who did not turn in their proxies.

The required number of stockholders to hold an annual

meeting for the Bering Straits Native Corporation is 3,128 and 2,333 shareholders were registered by 2 p.m. June 10, resulting in a shortfall of 795 votes.

The agenda for the annual meeting included 1) President's report and financial and audit reports; 2) election of eight directors; 3) ratification of direc-

tors' fees and per diem; 4) ratification of selection of Coopers and Lybrand as auditors for 1978 and 5) change of date of annual meeting.
