

# Contest features Native film, video produced in 1989

SAN FRANCISCO — The American Indian Film Institute is currently seeking entries for its 15th Annual American Indian Film Festival & Video Exposition to be held Nov. 8-10 at the Palace of Fine Arts in San Francisco.

Film or video to be entered for competition should be by or about Native Americans that were produced in 1989 or later. The seven major categories for competition are: Documentary Feature, Documentary Short, Commercial Feature, Docu-Drama, Live Short Subject, Animated Short Subject and Industrial.

The entry deadline for the 15th Annual American Indian Film Festival & Video Exposition is Sept. 13. Entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form, a signed regulation agreement form and a \$50 entry fee per each submitted for consideration. Entry fee payable: "American Indian Film Institute."

Promotional materials including production credits, black and white publicity stills, and a typewritten narrative description of each entry not exceeding 500 words should be included and forwarded. Entrants are also responsible for shipment to and from San Francisco.
