

# Village of Wainwright to Get Generator for Electricity

At last week's meeting of the board of Alaska State Community Action Program, Hugh Nicholls told the members that Max Brewer, director of the Arctic Research Laboratory, Barrow, offered him three 40-kw generators that the ARL was willing to give to the village of Wainwright.

This would finally give the village electricity it has

needed for a long time.

The generators are located 65 miles away from Wainwright at Icy Cape. When tundra conditions are right, the generators will be transported to the village by tractor and sled.

The acquisition of the generators will allow Wainwright to put additional money into wiring of more houses, Nicholls said.
