



A-PAINTING WE WILL GO-Brush, brush, brush—six Point Hope men are busily painting a special water storage building built this summer to house four 25,000 gallon wooden stave tanks for use by the Bureau of Indian Affairs installations at the village. The building is 105 feet by 24 feet. The water to fill the tanks will be pumped from the village well about a half a mile away but the villagers are dubious whether the well will furnish enough water or whether it will be pumped dry.
