

Bethel Area to Have District Welfare Man

JUNEAU, July 22, 1967—Alaska will have a district welfare worker in the Bethel area for the first time with the appointment last week of Lonnie Baker.

Baker will work with Acting District Rep. Douglas Peterson in the vast Bethel area, Dr. John Chapman, commissioner of Health and Welfare announced.

He said that Mr. Baker comes to Alaska with a background of many years social work experience with the public welfare departments of both New Mexico and California.
